- **Goal:** More lucrative and resilient rural livelihoods under climate variability & change and land degradation.
- **Objective:** Widespread understanding and application of sustainable land management practices
- **Countries:** Kaz., Kyr., Taj., Tur., Uzb.
- **Duration:** 3 years (2013-2016)
- **Donor/Budget:** IFAD 1.4 mill

Outputs & outcomes



- Knowledge about SLM in CA countries is synthesized, packaged and disseminated in forms that facilitate wide spread uptake by various stakeholders
- Operational knowledge platform to provide updated information about SLM accompanied by clear strategy to assure sustainability and link with worldwide resources
- Established KM system that facilitate coordination and policy dialogue for sustainable use and development of shared knowledge platform
