#### • What is the portal about?

**Systematic** and **user-friendly** repository of knowledge and information about innovative solutions, success stories and case studies in rural development.

**South-South and Triangular Cooperation (SSTC)** activities by sharing relevant rural development solutions and knowledge, promoting investments among developing countries; and establishing and supporting partnerships and other forms of collaboration for improved rural livelihoods.

#### What is a solution?

Rural solutions are specific initiatives/activities within a project/program. Not a program or a project.



## How does it work?

- Showcase innovations: Stories
- Wide range: Geographical regions and topics
- Link up with international organizations: World Bank, the Inter-American Development Bank, and other United Nations agencies
- Accessibility: Smallholder farmers and users
- Evaluation: 3 main, 11 other and 3 additional criterias
