DRUPAL WEB SERVICE

- We've used Drupal Feeds module to import data from several web services i.e. MEL and UBW to import content to the ICARDA site using custom modules.
- Custom Mappings must be defined to make the imported data usable
- The web services provided data for 6 content types
 - [Job Vacancies, Experts, Publications, Projects, Donors and Offices].
- Some content types have an image field e.g.
 - Example URL: '
https://apps.icarda.org/external/api/photo/***@cgiar.org/ '
- Images have to pass through an authentication process which requires the web service credential username and password. Only after the images are accessible can they be passed to the feeds module to continue the import of the content.
