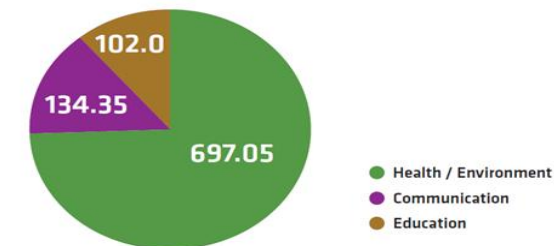

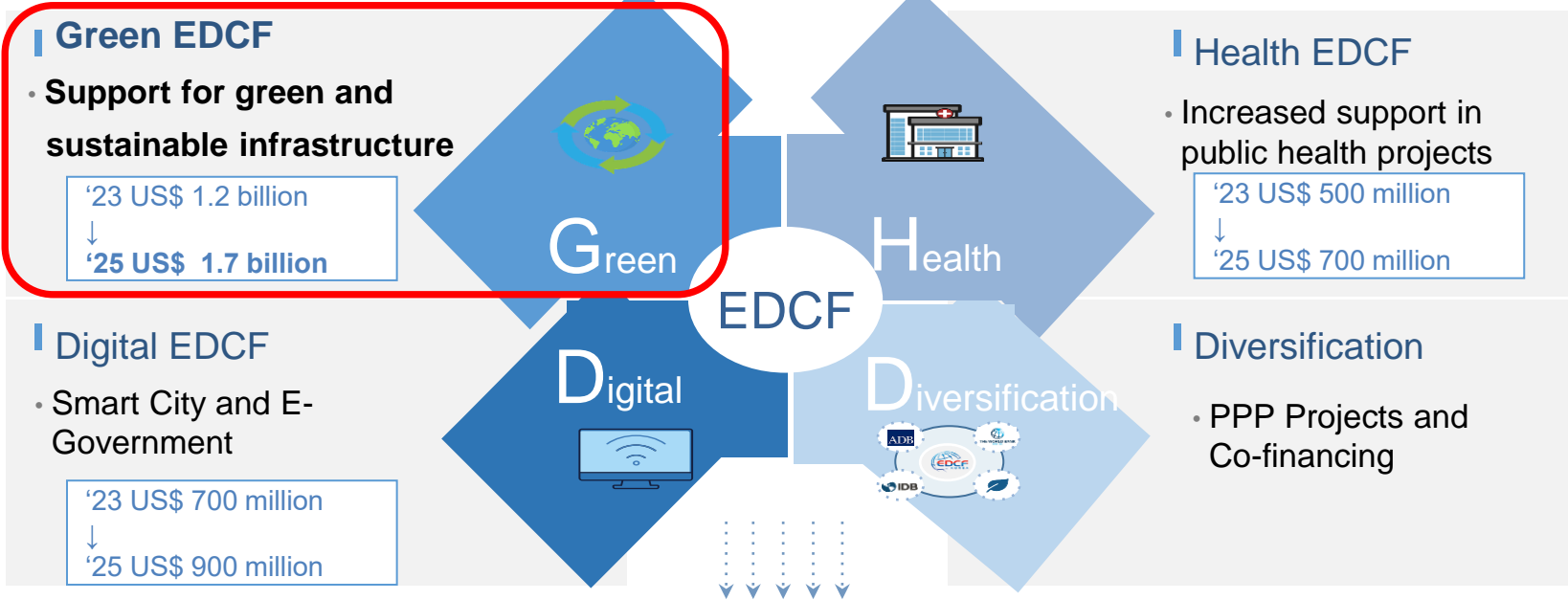

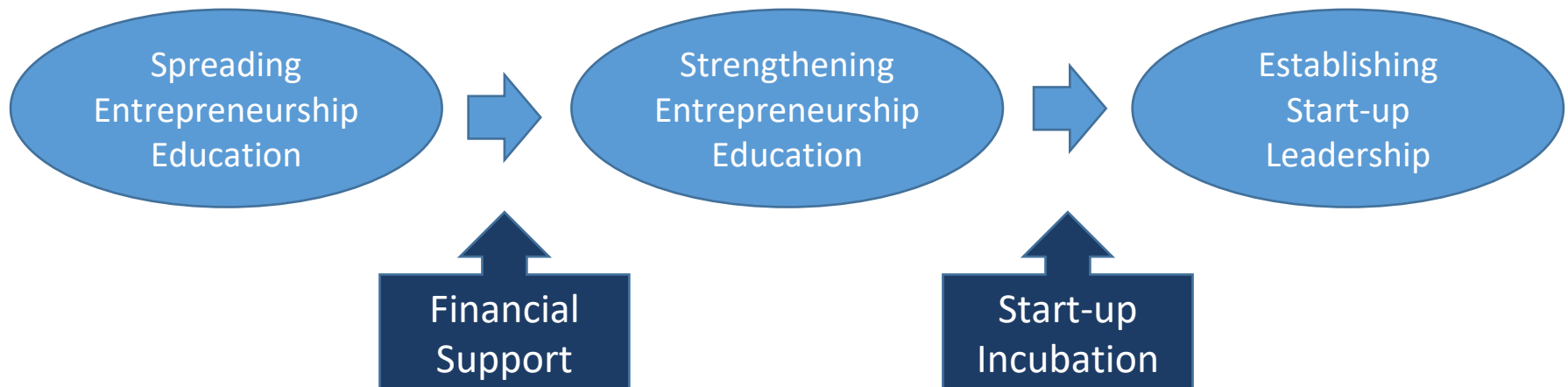
Project Outline

Project Purpose

Enhancing regional development in Karakalpakstan by contributing increase income expectations, promoting regional development and hence eliminating gender inequality.
