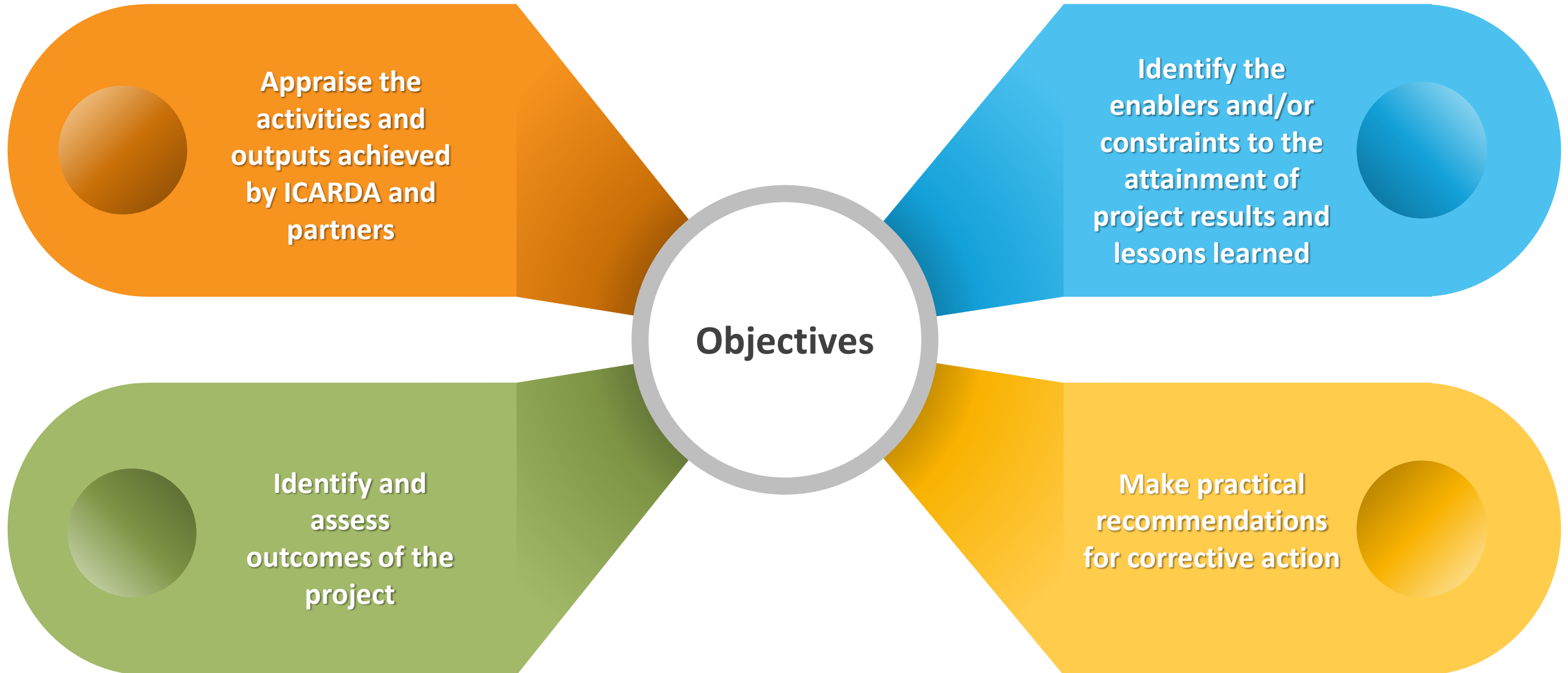

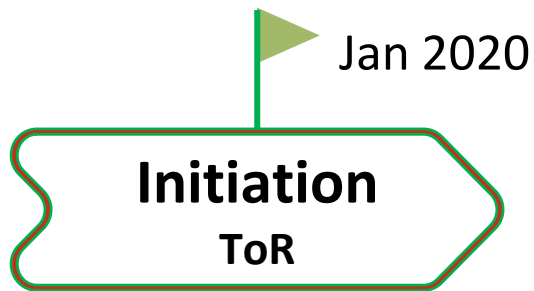

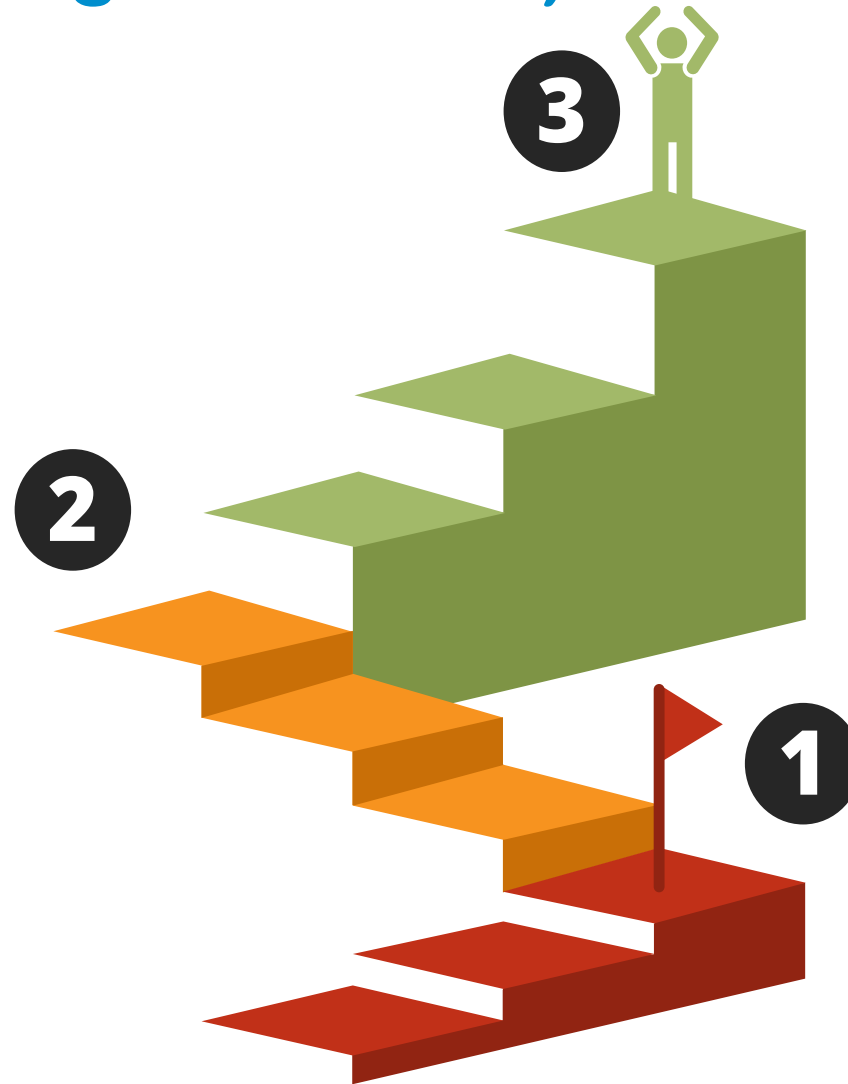


Mid-Term Evaluation Process (Bid screening & selection)

Evaluate the Cost per Unit Value (CUV) of the proposed services

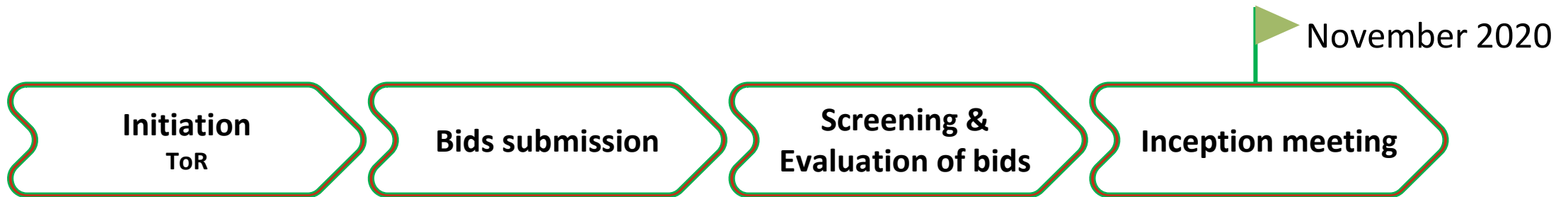

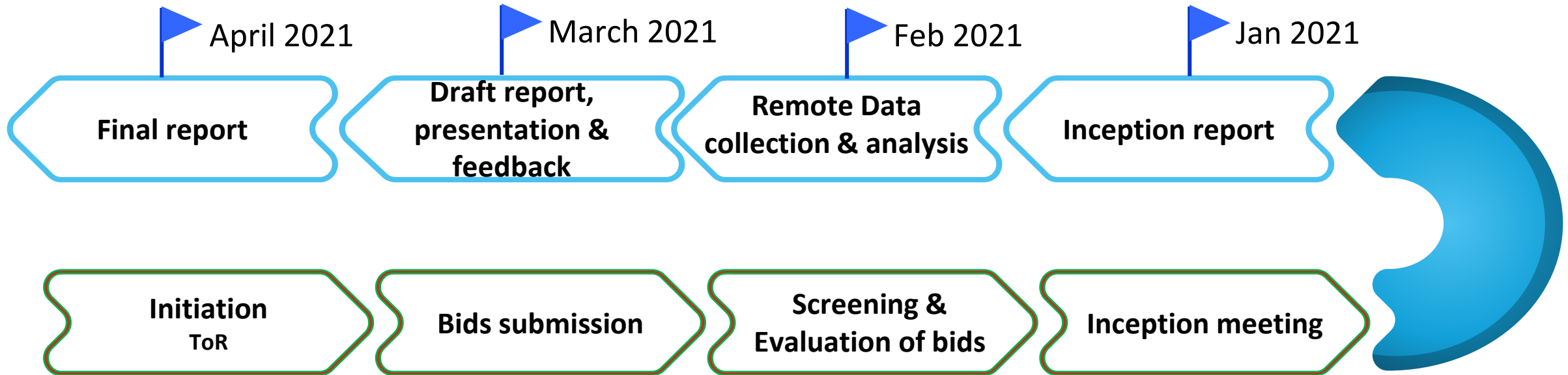
