

Youth Engagement for Agroecology

An Application of Photovoice Methodology in the Tunisian Agroecological Living Landscape – A Case Study from the Community of Kesra

Background:

Photo voice is a participatory research method that empowers individuals, typically marginalized or underrepresented groups, to use photography and storytelling to express their experiences, perspectives, and aspirations. The goal of using photo voice in this study is to engage young women and men in documenting and sharing their views on rural livelihoods, agriculture, and agroecology. Through photo voice, participants can highlight their opportunities, challenges, needs and aspirations related to these issues. It also aims to facilitate youth engagement in stakeholder discussions, elevate their concerns, and foster cross-cultural connections and learning through social media platforms. Ultimately, the goal is to generate actionable insights that address the underrepresentation of young women and men in farmers' collective action groups and agriculture, and to inform stakeholders.

Objectives:

The focus of Workshop-I is to:

- 1. Clarify the purpose of the study, emphasizing the research questions (RQ) and the importance of participant engagement.
- 2. Foster a sense of camaraderie and trust among participants to facilitate open discussion and collaboration.
- 3. Explore and refine photo prompts to ensure that they effectively stimulate participant engagement and guide photo selection.
- 4. Provide hands-on instruction in camera operation and basic techniques to empower participants to capture high-quality images.
