4. Dual education for young people – future farmers

- Seminars at international, regional and national knowledge exchange
 - seminars on conservation agriculture system and organic agriculture with farmers from Ukraine, Russia, Belarus, Kazakhstan and Moldova
 - summer school in the frame of the project “Eating City” with participation of young people from European and Mediterranean countries as well as from other regions of the world
 - national scientific-practical conference on sustainable development of agriculture
 - seminars in the frame of Moldovan Association for Organic Producers with releasing of certificate of completion the courses
